Childcare

Before & After School Care, Early-Release days, and Vacation Camp



We still have openings in both our before and after school childcare programs! Before care runs from 7am to 8:30am and aftercare runs from 3pm to 5:30pm in the gym at HB Emery. Before Care is \$40 per child per week and After Care is \$60 per child per week. This program is overseen by our childcare coordinator, Jamie-Lynn Worden and her staff. Children have a variety of activities to choose from including structured and unstructured play both inside and outside, daily snack, arts and crafts, and group activities. Winter Basketball

We will be offering basketball programs for boys and girls this winter for grades 1st-6th. Please see details below!

1st-2nd Grade Basketball Clinic

This clinic will be an introduction to basic basketball fundamentals and game play, using drills and leadup games. There may be one game towards the end of the session.
